



6. *A copy of my APAR for the period April 2010 to March 2011 (which should have been shown to me before 30/9/2011) - needed to show the criminal conspiracy in the conduct of enquiry which clearly establishes that findings had been decided as early as in April 2010 as revealed by the Presenting Officer on 17/2/2011(My complaint to the Police dated 11/3/2011 and confidential documents given to the DG & IG of Karnataka Police has more details about the criminal conspiracy)*

7. *Action taken on my representations on APARs for*

- i. *the period Jan 2007 to March 2007(about holding me mentally ill),*
- ii. *April 2007 to March 2008(about holding me mentally ill and initiating Disciplinary Proceedings after H.E. the governor has not agreed) and*
- iii. *April 2008 to March 2009 (needed to show what action was taken against those criminally conspired to write the APAR) -this is needed to show criminal tampering of records to subject me to enquiry*

8. ***Annexure 'A' mentioned at internal page 92 of the enclosed partial report enclosed to DPAR letter dated 21/10/2011- without giving complete report , representation cannot be given particularly when practicing Consultant was allowed to act as IA in spite of many objections***

I gave two hand written letters on 31/10/2011 while sitting in the Conference Hall, Vidhana Soudha at about 10.45 am seeking 5 minutes time from Chief Secretary to speak about the importance of the anti-corruption Pledge(which makes it mandatory for all government servants to fight corruption in all spheres of life and educate the public) and the *Vigilant Eye Program*(which allows corrupt practices to be video graphed by any government servant in any office). The first letter I gave it to the Chief Secretary through his Personal Secretary with acknowledgment and the second letter through Sri Markandeya, Under Secretary (convener of the program) on 31/10/2011 in Conference Hall , Vidhana Soudha before the commencement of Vigilance Awareness Week program(reduced to one minute program). The total lack of response from the


Chief Secretary on 31/10/2011 reinforced my belief that it would be meaningless to expect only my enquiry to be held in a fair manner when everything associated with anti-corruption measures are grossly unfair.

However, in the interest of whistleblowers it is important to respond to the extremely biased report of the Consultant & IA. Even the partial report received by me on 29/10/2011 reveals the Consultant & IA's extreme bias, prejudice and deliberate suppression and distortion of facts. This fact was revealed on 17/2/2011 by none other than the Presenting Officer Sri Richard Lobo (My email dated 21/2/2011 sent to all IAS officers of Karnataka Cadre and other Authorities in India under the caption *Height of Unfairness*) and my complaint given to Cubbon Park Police on 11/3/2011 and in my many subsequent letters.

I request the DA & CS to direct the concerned to make available immediately all the above mentioned documents to enable me to complete the formality of responding to the enquiry report. Documents at Sl. No. 4 to 7 should have been given mandatorily long back without making any request (not showing this in spite of many reminders has already amounted to utter contempt of Hon'ble Supreme Court directive of Aug 2010 by the Chief Secretary). Document mentioned at Sl No. 8 should have been given along with the enquiry report. **As far as documents mentioned at serial Nos 1, 2, and 3 are concerned the amount and the office to which fee for getting the certified copies to be paid be intimated to me immediately.**

**I will be giving my response to the entire enquiry report within 15 days from the date of receipt of ALL documents shown at Sl No. 1 to 8(including Sl No 8 which is the deliberately left out portion of the Enquiry Report).**
