ORDER

1. Sri A. R. S. Kumar, represents the Appellant. Respondent is absent.
2. Appellant states that the information furnished is incomplete. He further states the PIO should have transferred the copy of the application to the PIO of the concerned Department where such information was available as according to the respondent, the information regarding disposal of the file was not available in his office. He requests this Commission to direct the Respondent to transfer the application to the concerned Department for furnishing the information. He further states that particulars of the attendance and copies of allegations made against other officers are not furnished in the Para No. 4 of the letter dated 17-12-2012 through which information was furnished and states that in the event of non-availability of the attendance register, the details of the leave availed by the officer and salary particulars should be provided to him.
