**Sub:** Requesting Sri Kaushik Mukherjee, Chief Secretary to clarify and reveal certain information in larger public interest to revive the dignity of the office of Chief Secretary  
**Ref:** My letter dated 26/10/2013 addressed to you when you were Additional Chief Secretary

Dear Sri Kaushik Mukherjee,

In the letter under reference addressed to you, I had asked you take go through that letter and my other enclosed letters dated 15/10/2013 and 26/10/2013. I had also asked you to get my letters dated 20/10/2012 and 14/6/2013 from Sri Sanjiv Kumar, Principal Secretary, DPAR to know how I have been criminally obstructed to prevent me from performing my present duties. I had also drawn your attention to my letters regarding the role played by senior AIS officers in promoting illegal mining in Karnataka. In fact letters I wrote to your successors in Forest Dept. gives elaborate and exhaustive details.

Some reports in newspapers that have appeared since you became Chief Secretary have made me to write the following.

An extract from the Hindu dated 1/11/2013 reads as follows: *Addressing presspersons soon after taking charge, Mr. Mukherjee said that "mining in forest areas with permission is legal" and the "Bellary mining scam is a small dot in the country".*

I waited till today to read a corrigendum in that newspaper if you had not said as reported. I am unable to understand how a scam which shook the very roots of democracy not just in Karnataka but in the country could be termed by you as *a small dot in the country*. I did not expect such a statement from an officer who was the Principal Secretary of Forest Department during the period when illegal mining peaked. My documentations since 2007 show how your predecessors in your present posting went out of the way to protect senior AIS officers involved in promoting illegal mining

ಅಧಿಕಾರ ಸ್ವೀಕರಿಸಿದ ನಂತರ ಸುದ್ದಿ ಗಾಂಧಿ ಜತೆ ಪೂಜಾಪಾಡಿದ ಕೌಶಿಕ್ ಮುಖರ್ಜಿ, ಅತ್ಯಂತ ವಿಷಮೃತಿಯಿಂದ ನಾನು ಈ ಹುದ್ದೆಯನ್ನು ಸ್ವೀಕರಿಸಿದ್ದೇನೆ. ಪ್ರಾಪಂಚಿಕವಾಗಿ ಕರ್ತವ್ಯ ನಿರ್ವಹಿಸುತ್ತೇನೆ ಎಂದು ಭರವಸೆ ನೀಡಿದರು. ರಾಜ್ಯದ ಅಧಿಕಾರ ವರ್ಗ ಅತ್ಯಂತ ಸಮರ್ಥವಾಗಿದೆ. ಸರ್ಕಾರಿ ಪರಿಯ ದೃಢಿ 'ದೇವರು' ಎಂದೇ ಹೆಸರಿಟ್ಟ ರಂಗನಾಥ್ ಅವರು ಅಡಳಿತಕ್ಕೆ ಭದ್ರ ಬುನಾದಿ ಹಾಕಿಕೊಟ್ಟಿದ್ದಾರೆ. ಅವರ ಅಧಿಕಾರವನ್ನು ಪಾಲಿಸಿ ರಾಜ್ಯದ ಓತ ಯೋಜನೆಗಳನ್ನು ಸುಮಾರು ಕವಾಗಿ ಅನುಷ್ಠಾನಕ್ಕೆ ತರಲಾಗುವುದು ಎಂದರು.

I have also given to the left of this a scanned portion from *Kannada Prabha* dated 2/11/2013. I have enough documentation to show your predecessor Sri SV Ranganath was a godfather to many corrupt senior AIS officers and that by his deliberate omissions and commissions amounting to very serious criminal acts, he laid foundation for an extremely corrupt bureaucracy to thrive in Karnataka. No wonder after Sri SV Ranganath became Chief Secretary Karnataka got shamed as the most corrupt state in the country.

Such things even forced the then Hon'ble Chief Justice of Karnataka High Court to observe in open Court that he agreed with what magazines had been reporting that Karnataka is No 1 in corruption. Former Lokayukta Justice Sri Santosh Hegde's statement that if he was given suo moto powers, then both Vidhana Soudha and Vikasa Soudha would become empty within 24 hours captures a similar understanding of the reality. In fact, another former Chief Justice of India gave press statements that all Government Departments are run by the *mafia*. All these statement were made by Justices during the tenure of Sri SV.Ranganath. If Sri SV Ranganath is a *god* to you, then I shudder to even imagine your picture of a *devil*. It is fearing such things that I wrote my letter dated 15/10/2013 to Hon'ble Chief Minister.

To revive confidence in the office of Chief Secretary, I request you to put the following on GOK website:

1. Information about your movable and immovable assets( I have been requesting both GOI and GOK to put even my moveable assets on website since 2006)
2. Files containing complaints of misuse of office in your previous postings. If I had been given information needed to perform my present duties by DPAR, then I would have known about the following and likely some more cases:
  - a. Two complaints against you for which files are available in DPAR.
  - b. Two newspaper reports about misuse of your position.
  - c. An instance in which the High Court had pulled up your immediate successor for huge losses caused during your time running into a few hundreds of crores of rupees.
  - d. Another instance reported about certain revelations made by the CBI before the CBI Court regarding the role played by the Principal Secretary, Forest department in promoting illegal mining.

- Any conditions put by you (either orally or in writing) before accepting the post of Chief Secretary regarding non-interference in performing the duties of the Chief Secretary (Please get my letter dated 9/4/2010 written to your predecessor).
- Any oral instructions given by the Hon'ble Chief Minister since you became Chief Secretary (not doing so would amount to contempt of the recent Supreme Court judgment)

Taking action by you as requested above in larger public interest becomes very important as Parliamentary elections are going to be held shortly.

(1) This is to place on record that my APARs since 2008 have not been shown (vide my letters dated 20/10/2012, 6/2/2013, 14/6/2013 and many other letters since 2009). These APARs capture how Sri SV Ranganath criminally harassed and obstructed me for refusing to compromise with corruption and for continuing to act against the corrupt (2) He is also directed to make arrangements immediately to provide all information and staff sought by me since March 2011 to finalize the Departmental Enquiry Manual which is complete but for the information deliberately withheld by DPAR. He is also directed to insist in writing if any of his superiors orally instruct him not to provide the same. The Principal Secretary, DPAR, not doing so would only imply that Sri SV. Ranganath continues to control DPAR even after retirement.
