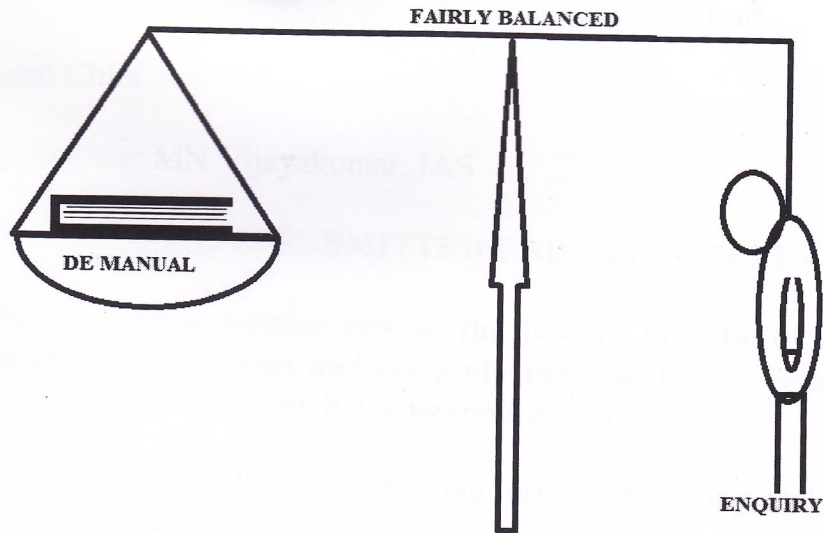


TRIAL OF A WHISTLEBLOWER



EXTRACT FROM THE ORDER OF IA & CONSULTANT JUSTICE SRI MP CHINNAPA(22/6/2011): It is unbearable for any authority to proceed with the enquiry

CONCLUDING REMARKS BY SRI R LOBO, PO (06/07/2011): *The attempts of the member of service to fight corruption is **nothing** to do with the present enquiry*

DoPT EXPERT COMMITTEE REPORT (July 2010) : *One of these is the tendency to browbeat members of the All-India Services through motivated action, including frequent transfers, transfers to posts which do not normally warrant posting of an officer of his seniority, suspension and **initiation of Disciplinary Inquiries without adequate basis**. Through such steps, State Governments humiliate and harass several officers of these Services, in effect warning others what can happen to them unless they, too, toe the line*

RECOMMENDATIONS OF SRI S KRISHNA KUMAR, ADVISOR TO GOVERNOR (5/12/2007): *I am not too sanguine about the efficacy of the proposed action. It is open ended and may not establish anything conclusive on which basis action can be taken. It may be best to transfer the officer and give him a more suitable job*

EXTRACT FROM MNV'S LETTER TO CS (27/1/2007): *: I don't think it helps the society if the Bureaucracy becomes insensitive to rampant corruption and wants to look the other way. **I believe that turning blind eyes to corruption is worse than being corrupt**. What I have reported to the Chief Secretaries is not done to show arrogance or disrespect. But to highlight the need to expose the corrupt irrespective of their status in the Bureaucracy, as only doing this can help to improve things. Corrupt practices of a senior officer, corrupts the entire organization he heads. Because of this, I get upset with the corrupt practices of senior officers as it increases poverty, effects health of all, forces children to work, farmers to commit suicide, increases unemployment leading to creation of more criminals, terrorism etc, and finally make honest people a laughing stock.*

EXTRACT FROM THE LETTER OF SRI PS APPU TO CHIEF MINISTER (19/7/1977) *I am not laying down the above conditions out of any arrogance or the feeling that I am indispensable. I am doing it keeping in my mind the public interest as well as my personal interest. In my opinion the administration will not be able to deliver the goods unless the above conditions are fulfilled. It will be a tragedy for Bihar if the administration headed by the present CM, also fails. **Public interest demands that everything possible should be done to prevent that**. My personal interest is that I shall lose whatever reputation I have if I agree to serve as Chief Secretary without adequate authority to play an effective role. If the conditions prevailing in Bihar during the last few years are allowed to continue even a superman will not be able to deliver the goods. And of course I am no superman.*
